

The information provided regarding the criminal career of William Fyfe is limited and therefore this book doesn't have a lot to add as far as why he committed them or what caused him to behave in such a vicious manner. Mr. Swinney provides his own speculations based upon a career in law enforcement, so they carry some weight. However, in the end, there are more questions remaining than answers.

Another fine addition to the Crimes Canada series under the direction of RJ Parker. Swinney really has a problem on his hands because although we know many of the details of the crimes he committed, the reader is left wondering about the motive. Most serial killers are caught up in an endless cycle that will continue unless stopped by law enforcement. Many of these killers have done at least a little reflection on why they chose to engage in these activities. Ted Bundy, for example, provided numerous accounts for his actions, even if the reader decides that it's simple rationalization. What makes Fyfe interesting is that he refuses to discuss or speculate on the motives for his crimes: "That's for me to know." For this reason, I give high marks to Swinney because he tackles a subject who refuses to reveal the inner workings of his own mind. The book is baffling, entertaining, and well researched. Please continue to write for your eager audience!

sentence for committing 1 or 25 murders. Chris Sweeny hit this out of the park. Captivating and graphic!

Thanks to forensic science and one smudged partial fingerprint, this brutal serial murderer was finally caught after a 20-year "career" in killing. This guy was so clever, he never left anything that investigators could use to solve the crimes. He kept to himself and flew under-the-radar for a long time. Unlike other serial killers, he didn't seek notoriety for his crimes. Even after he was caught, he wouldn't say much. He still won't. So information on him and his motives is limited. Despite this, the author does a good job on recounting the facts of the crimes, the frustration of the police departments and the fear the citizens of Quebec went through.

This book is about William Patrick Fyfe. This "normal" looking man could turn into a stone cold killer at the drop of a hat. His life as an adult consisted of many convictions,. Thief, dependency on drugs and the desire to kill. . Now throw this in a mix, and you have a ticking bomb.....When he did do some odd jobs, it was to feed his addiction. What he did, had me turning the pages as fast as I could. The book is an attention grabber, well written and won't disappoint.

I read a lot of True Crime. But really. WHY was this book published? The author tells us repeatedly that there is little or no information on this subject. If for some reason it MUST be published, I suggest this as the full text: "This man committed nine murders and sexual crimes, he was caught by a clue, was arrested, convicted and incarcerated for the crimes."
